Your friends/family are welcome to park underground however they will be required to have a token to leave. The tokens can be purchased at the front desk. There are no in & out privileges for drop off of items or people. At the front entrance, 2100 Bloor Street, there is a temporary drop off section and residents have access to A building entrance and D building entrance.

Pets: We love pets here at The Grenadier, we are very pet friendly, however please remember that all animals must be kept on a leash or in a cage while outside of your suite. Also, animals are not allowed in the dining room, the library or at events when food is being served unless the animal is for medical support and is

accompanied by the person requiring such support. Pets are not to be left unaccompanied at any time and they must be secured so that pathways and walkways are clear for all residents/guests/staff to use.

Important Announcement: During the first 2 weeks of July the bathrooms located at the back of the dining room will be converted back into designated Female and Male washrooms for Grenadier resident use. The 2 bathrooms located across from the theatre room will be locked and will be for guest and staff use.
